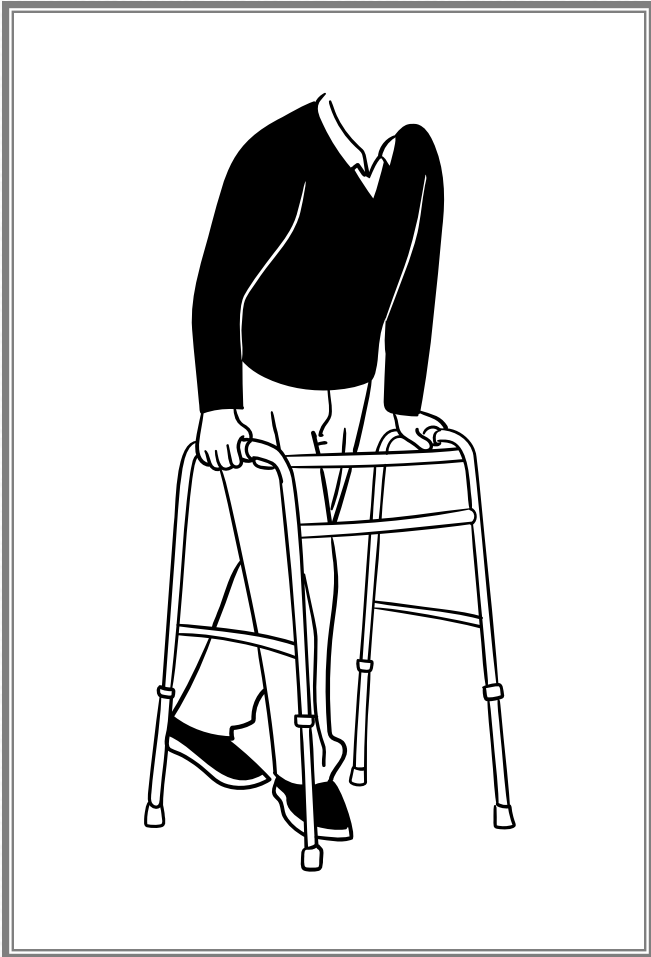

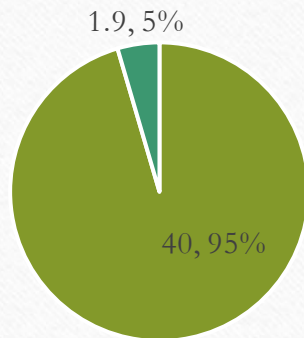
# Our Goal

Provide Independence for those of different ability. Primarily focusing on individuals who depend on walkers for their mobility.

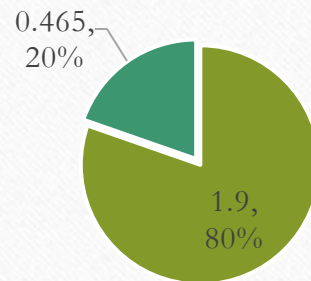
# Why Care? Who Does this Impact?

- Total
- Requiring use of a Walker

- Third Most Prevalent Cause of Disability
- Impacts 1 in 20 Canadians
- 1/5<sup>th</sup> of Canadians with Mobility Limitations Require a Walker to aid Mobility
- Providing Challenges to Everyday Tasks
